DOCTOR, M.D. is endangering the public health through misleading LASIK advertising which fails to reveal facts about risks and adverse surgical effects.

I request that the FDA take immediate action to stop deceptive and misleading advertising of LASIK by DOCTOR, M.D., using all remedies available to the Agency.
